Cycles

Definition:

• An interval of time during which a characteristic, often regularly repeated event or sequence of events occurs

Examples of cyclic "order":

- Tidal
- Lunar
- Economic
- Market




Economic Cycles

- 56 60+ Long Wave
- 34 Year and 17 Year Historical Cycle
- 18 Year Kuznets Cycle
- 14 year Long Wave Seasons
- Decennial (10 year) Cyclical Pattern
- 7.25 Year Juglar Cycle
- 3.5 Year Kitchin Cycle
- 14 months Kitchen Season Cycle
- 20 Week Wall Cycle
- 35 Day Quarter Wall Cycle



Idealized Long Wave






3 month US T-bill Average Yields


U.S. Treasury Monthly Average Yields







Stock Market Cycles – S&P 500






Stock Market Cycles – DAX





Stock Market Cycles – FTSE 100






